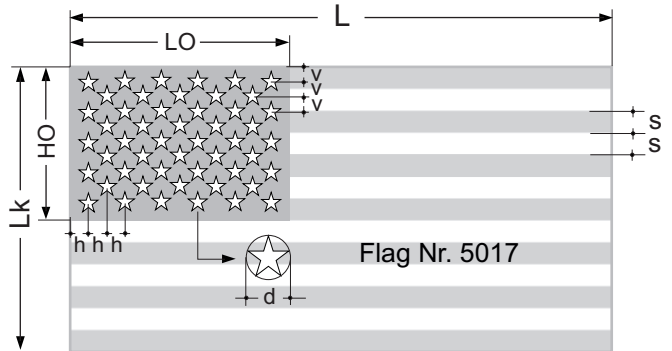

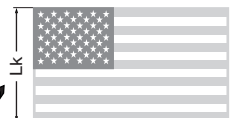

Chronological development of the American Stars and Stripes (specifically composed for the ship-model-construction)

Comment:

Legally, only the number of the stars and strips, the order of the stars and that were stipulated. Size of the left uppercorner was left the manufacturers consequently. Is in the civilian and trade-shipping so many partly very beautiful structures originated. However with her/it of the navy, the stars became on the basis of one Order of president Monroe in the year 1818 mainly in rows represented. That was valid until 1912, from since at gave it precise rules for finished.

In addition, there were many ensigns and it is located new again and again, that invented freely or as Design puts remained and never official became, for example 16 stars or 39 stars.

Such ensigns should come in the model-construction only in exceptions to the application.

Lt. Ensign-law of 1818 is valid and A. also that in each case new stars on July 4 the the joining following Year is added. The year date from 1818 don't therefore mean the joining-year but the introductory-year of the new ensign.

1775 - 1777: Grand union or better known as " Continental Colors ", existing from 13 strips and with union Jack, still without Andreas-cross of Ireland, in the upper left corner. Followed instead of the Union Jack the stars on blue reason:

1777: 13 stars circularly or 5 x vertically: 3, 2, 3, 2, 3 and 13 stripes til 1795

1795: 15 stars vertically: 3, 2, 3, 2, 3, 2 and 15 stripes til 1818,

1818: 20 stars horizontally 4 rows x 5, and again 13 stripes til today,

1819: 21 stars 4 rows: 5, 4, 6, 6 or 6, 4, 5, 6

1820: 23 stars 4 rows: 6, 5, 6, 6

1822: 24 stars 4 rows x 6

1836: 25 stars 4 rows: 6, 5, 7, 7

1837: 26 stars 4 rows: 7, 6, 6, 7

1845: 27 stars 4 rows: 7, 6, 7, 7

1846: 28 stars 4 rows x 7
