Nelson's Signal at Trafalgar 1805



It frequently is asked for the mast, at which this signal was hoisted.

The single hint to this is found in the English web page

It is called there:

Where was the signal made?

Because it is normal today to see the whole signal flying at one time from the various masts and yards of the Victory - there is a misconception that this is how it would have looked when originally flown.

In fact the flag lockers were located at the back of the poop deck, **and the signals would have been made using the mizzen mast only.**

The signal became temporal with big likelihood consecutively placed in 4 parts:

- 1.) Preparatory flag...England expects..
- 2.) ...that every Man...
- 3.) ...will do his...
- 4.) ...Duty... finishing flag.

Here, one clearly also recognizes the purpose of this preparatory and finishing flags.

With festive occasions, particularly warships in the harbor and on the roadstead ensign-gala.

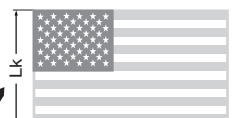

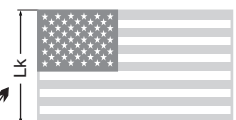

Early sets of signal flags (start of development of systematic flag codes) can be made on demand. These are e.g. the flag sets of Sir Charles Knowles 1778, Lord Howe 1794, Captain Frederik Marryat, Charles de Reynold.

Also the English, French and Prussian flag sets from that time, and the flags of the international signal book of 1901, which is the predecessor of today's set of flags (since 1933). (see flags No. 7001 - 7110)

Available is also the German Navy flag set of World War II (50 flags per set).

Please note:

Signal flags are often named by letters of the alphabet, but do not always have that meaning. The meaning is given by the combination of the flags and the place where the flag is hoisted. These codes and their meanings are listed in the navy flag books. The flag books differ from country to country and with time, and are very comprehensive. So sometimes there are more or less flags on the total set than the alphabet has letters.

Substitutes

The auxiliary flags are required as a substitute to other flags because in a flag of each sentence Point occurs only once.
